## Notification of Victim's/Witness' Rights

As a victim/witness of crime at the Memphis International Airport, the Memphis Airport Police Department shall provide notice of the following information:

1. The victim's/witness' rights under the Tennessee Constitution, article I 35, to be free from intimidation, harassment, and abuse throughout the criminal system.
2. The availability, if any, of crisis intervention services, emergency and/or medical services.
3. The name of the law enforcement agency and telephone number.
4. The name and telephone number of public and private victim/witness assistance programs, including the state criminal injuries compensation program and programs that provide counseling, treatment, and other support services; and,
5. The procedural steps involved in criminal prosecution.

### VICTIM'S/WITNESS RIGHTS

*The right to confer with prosecution.*

*The right to be free from intimidation, harassment, and abuse throughout the criminal justice system.*

*The right to be present at all proceedings where the defendant has the right to be present.*

*The right to be heard, when relevant, at all critical stages of the criminal justice process as defined by statute.*

*The right to be informed of all proceedings and the release, transfer, escape, or recapture of the accused or convicted person.*

*The right to a speedy trial or disposition and a prompt conclusion of the case after conviction or sentence.*

*The right to restitution from the offender.*

*The right to be informed of each of the rights established for victim/witness.*
